

Holly Ward The Future Is Now

The latest work of Vancouver-based artist Holly Ward combines tropes of modernist architecture, science fiction movie sets and utopian design in an interactive, electro-acoustic, sculptural installation.

Holly Ward's the Future Is Now was constructed during her residency at the Banff Centre for the Arts in the winter of 2004. Ward has recently participated in the traveling *Soundtracks* exhibition, and will be attending Guelph University to undergo her MFA in September 2004. The Future Is Now will be exhibited at YYZ in Toronto in the summer of 2004.

Dani Gal HOLDUP

HOLDUP is a computer animation made with six images from a short sequence of surveillance camera footage of a bank robbery. Using this footage, Gal constructed a motion picture that simulates the experience of looking through a kaleidoscope. The footage of the bank robbery is only visible at a point in the film when the film rewinds itself. By looking at a hypnotic or psychedelic image and shifting to a position of soberness and control, the role of the viewer changes from that of an innocent bystander to a witness.
